TIMOTHY

A convert from Paul's first apostolic mission – Paul became his mentor *Ac* 14:26-27; 1Ti 1:1-2 His circumcision by Paul explained *Ac* 16:1-3 Somewhat fearful and timid 1Cor 16:10; 2Ti 1:7 Was comparatively young 1Ti 4:12

TITHES

Obligatory under Old Covenant *Mt 23:23* Not obligatory for New Testament Christians *Ga 6:7-8; He 7:1-10*

TITLES

Forbidden for Christians Mt 20:28, 23:8-12

TITUS

Co-worker with Paul Tit 1:4, 1:5-9

TONGUES

The sure evidence that one is baptised with Holy Spirit *Mt* 3:11; *Mk* 16:17-18; *Lu* 24:49; *Jn* 7:37-39, 14:15-17; *Ac* 2:1-4(*A*), 2:1-4(*B*), 8:14-17, 8:18-23; *Ro* 8:26-27; 1Cor 12:1-11(*A*), 12:1-11(*B*), 13:8-12, 14:1-5; *Jude* 20

TREE OF LIFE

Is literal tree – the leaves of which will preserve human life throughout eternity *Rev* 22:1-2

TRIBULATION, the

Designates the Three-in-One Godhead of Christianity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit Mt 1:18-21, 3:16-17; Lu

VIRGIN BIRTH OF JESUS
